RESOLUTION 2021-03

- A RESOLUTION OF THE BEXLEY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT BOARD OF SUPERVISORS ADOPTING POLICIES FOR THE USE OF THE PONDS WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE DISTRICT; PROVIDING FOR MODIFICATION OR TERMINATION OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
- **WHEREAS**, the Bexley Community Development District (the "District") a local unit of special purpose government organized and existing in accordance with Chapter 190, Florida Statutes, owns and maintains certain ponds located within the boundaries of the District (the "Ponds"); and
- **WHEREAS,** the Ponds are potions of the stormwater management infrastructure improvements which are part of the capital improvement program for the District as outlined in the Bexley Community Development District Report of District Engineer dated March 15, 2016; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Ponds were designed to meet the permit criteria of the Southwest Florida Water Management District and Pasco County; and
- **WHEREAS**, the District Board of Supervisors (the "Board") has the right to establish policies governing the use of the Ponds; and
- **WHEREAS**, in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the public, residents and landowners within the District, the Board desires to implement a policy governing public use of the Ponds which prohibits swimming, and other recreational activities including but not limited to use of boats, kayaks, canoes, and other floatation devices within the Ponds; and
- **WHEREAS**, the District desires to reserve the right to modify or terminate this Resolution at any time in the future.
 - NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF BEXLEY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT AS FOLLOWS:
- **Section 1.** <u>Authority for this Resolution</u>. This Resolution is adopted pursuant to Chapters 190, Florida Statutes.
- **Section 2.** <u>Adoption of Policies for the Use of the Ponds</u>. The District hereby adopts the policy that swimming and other recreational activities including but not limited to use of kayaks, boats, canoes, and other floatation devices within District Ponds is prohibited.
