SECOND ORDER OF BUSINESS Audience Comments

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THIRD ORDER OF BUSINESS

Public Hearing on Fiscal Year 2023/2024 Final Budget

On a motion from Mr. Williams, seconded by Ms. Pettit, with all in favor the Board unanimously opened the public hearing on fiscal year 2023/2024 final budget, for the Bexley Community Development District.

Residents questioned the pond bank mowing, wetland mitigation, administrative fees, employee salaries, and overall increase in the budget.

On a motion from Mr. Williams, seconded by Mr. Blakley, with all in favor the Board unanimously closed the public hearing on fiscal year 2023/2024 final budget, for the Bexley Community Development District.

i. Consideration of Resolution 2023-08, Adopting Fiscal Year 2023/2024 Final Budget

Ms. Minichino presented Resolution 2023-08 and the Board requested that \$80,640 allocated for pond bank mowing be moved to the miscellaneous contingency account. It was noted that the change does not impact the budget total of \$2,073,626.

On a motion from Mr. Williams, seconded by Ms. Pettit, with all in favor the Board unanimously approved Resolution 2023-08, as amended, adopting fiscal year 2023/2024 final budget totaling \$3,618,216.29 (general fund-\$2,126,751 and \$1,491,465.29-debt service, for the Bexley Community Development District.

FOURTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Public Hearing Imposing Special Assessments

On a motion from Mr. Williams, seconded by Mr. Blakley with all in favor the Board unanimously opened the public hearing on imposing special assessments, for the Bexley Community Development District.

Mr. Williams explained the special assessments for the audience. There were no questions put forward.

On a motion from Mr. Williams, seconded by Ms. Klenke, with all in favor the Board unanimously closed the public hearing on imposing special assessments, for the Bexley Community Development District.

i. Consideration of Resolution 2023-09, Imposing Fiscal Year 2023/2024 Assessments

Ms. Minichino presented Resolution 2023-09. There were no questions.

On a motion from Mr. Williams, seconded by Ms. Klenke, with all in favor the Board unanimously approved Resolution 2023-09, Levying 2023/2024 assessments and certifying the assessment roll, for the Bexley Community Development District.

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FIFTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Staff Reports

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A. District Counsel

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Ms. Wilson stated that she is working with the current engineer to wrap up tasks and preparing the completion of project filing.

B. District Engineer

Mr. Tito informed the Board that Clearview land Design, LLP will be resigning as District Engineer as soon as the priority list of projects is completed. He updated the Board on the status of the projects, noting that he will have proposals to present to the Board next month.

Mr. Tito explained that he is reviewing the permits for the series 2016 bonds to determine if they can be deemed completed or what still needs to be done. It was stated that there is a parcel of land by the Tower Road extension that is still owned by the Developer.

C. Aquatics Reports

Mr. Agnew and Ms. Berger reviewed the Aquatics Report and responded to questions. It was stated that they are on site every Tuesday plus three additional days every month. Ms. Berger will review pond 1A, while she is onsite this Thursday as well as ensuring the weeds along the trail have been addressed. The neighborhood brunch and learn is still in the works.

D. Landscape Inspection Report

A resident complimented the appearance of the community.

E. Landscape Contractors Response Report

Mr. Hemelgarn shared his updates and plans to have fifteen people on site this Friday to address issues noted in the report. He presented a proposal to install Sweet Gum on Jersey Pass.

On a motion from Ms. Klenke, seconded by Mr. Williams, the Board unanimously approved the Juniper proposal to install Sweet Gum on Jersey Pass in the amount of \$4,547.52, for the Bexley Community Development District.

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F. Clubhouse Manager

i. Presentation of Clubhouse Report

Mr. Berthold updated the Board on the status of the playground, noting that the inspection is scheduled for August 28th.

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G. District Manager

Ms. Minichino informed the Board that the next regular Board meeting is scheduled for September 27, 2023, at 1:00 p.m. at the office of Rizzetta and 121 Company, located at 5844 Old Pasco Road, Suite 100 Wesley Chapel, FL 33544.

A brief discussion was held regarding the need to expedite the RFQ for District Engineer to have responses by next month's meeting, if possible. The estimated costs for the stormwater repairs (\$20,000 to \$50,000) by Sitemasters was also discussed with it being noted that Clearview will serve to certify this project.

On a motion from Mr. Blakley, seconded by Mr. Williams, the Board unanimously authorized Management to advertise an RFQ for engineering services, for the Bexley Community Development District.
